

## Placement of Automated External Defibrillators in Nova Scotia Communities

In the event of a cardiac arrest it is critically important that the person suffering this medical emergency receive good CPR and a shock from an AED without delay. Many studies have proven that minutes literally save lives. Recognizing this the Jordan Boyd Foundation has partnered with EHS Nova Scotia to place Automated External Defibrillators (AED's) in Nova Scotia communities or facilities where many people gather and access to an AED may be delayed. In the past year, the Jordan Boyd Foundation has placed an AED at the following locations in Nova Scotia:

- Milford Recreation Centre - Milford, NS
- Free Spirit Therapeutic Riding Association - Aylesford, NS
- New Glasgow Farmers Market - New Glasgow, NS
- Sherbrooke Lake Church Camp - Franey's Corner, NS
